2012 COACH GUN ESTATE GROWN • NAPA VALLEY

Appellation/Vineyards | Priest Ranch wines are all estate grown and bottled from our historic 1615 acre property. In 2012, the grapes for this wine were chosen from five separate hillside blocks.

Winemaking | Our 2012 Coach Gun was handpicked, sorted, and fermented naturally, then aged 28 months in 50% new French oak barrels. The blend was refined over the course of the first year of aging. The final blend was determined just a few months before bottling.

Harvest Notes | The 2012 vintage was a classic, near perfect growing season with warm days and cool nights. The mild summer and warm weather after veraison caused the fruit to develop with good balance, great flavors, bright acidity, and mature well developed tannins.

Tasting Notes | *"The 2012 Coachgun is Priest Ranch's Cabernet Sauvignon-based blend. A rich, explosive wine, the 2012 saturates the palate with notable intensity and pure power. Dark red/black fruit, espresso, grilled herbs and licorice are some of the many notes that open up in this voluptuous yet powerful wine from Priest Ranch."*
