



Parcel 41 Sauvignon Blanc 2013

The name Parcel 41 is derived from the original agriculture land assessor's plot number for our ranch in Napa Valley, California

Aging: This pure version of Sauvignon Blanc was cold fermented in stainless steel, and saw no oak in its aging.

Tasting notes: The 2013 Parcel 41 Sauvignon Blanc is a crowd pleaser and a thirst quencher. Aromas of wet stone, Meyer lemon, lime, and a hint of lychee greet your nose, while flavors of mandarin orange and kaffir lime leaf lightly frame the wine's mineral core. Candied lemon peel lingers on the wine's light, clean finish. This wine is the perfect accompaniment to a plate of oysters with mignonette and lemon, or a basil-laden Thai red curry with chicken.
