Graham Beck Blanc de Blancs 2012

Pale yellow with a fresh, fine mousse. Lively aromas of lemon, truffle and spicy oak, with deeper-pitched leesy hints of butterscotch and honey. Mellow, broad and easygoing; frothy rather than hard, almost with a touch of sugar. Hints of soft citrus fruits and yeasty toasted bread make this wine delicious right now. Not a strict style but extract-rich, intense and very satisfying. Lively acidity makes itself felt with air and nicely extends the back end. I like this.
