Family-owned GBW sparkling wines are 100% Méthode Cap Classique which is the South African term for Méthode Champenoise. The Brut NV spends a minimum of two years bottle aging on-lees before disgorgement and is 100% hand harvested estate Pinot Noir & Chardonnay. GBW also produces vintage Brut Rosé, Blanc de Blancs, non-vintage Brut Rosé and a Demi-Sec, as well as a tête de cuvée, Cuvée Clive. Particular focus is on the NV Brut and the NV Brut Rose in the US.

The Brut NV is an iconic wine in South Africa and abroad. This is the wine which was served at Nelson Mandela's historic presidential inauguration. It is also favored by the Obamas who selected it to toast his election as president of the United States.

Game Reserve Wines are a socially responsible choice

The Game Reserve Cab, Shiraz, Chenin and Sauvignon Blanc are great options for BTG sub \$10.

Every dollar made from the Game Reserve Wines funds conservation efforts at the nearly 5,000 acre Game Preserve that the Beck Family has created (one of South Africa's largest privately held and protected wildlife conservation areas), where indigenous wildlife finds refuge from encroaching urbanization and threatened plant species are restored and thrive under the guidance of a full-time conservationist.

GBW is the only SA winery to have received three internationally recognized environmental and business ethics accreditations: "Championship Status" from the Biodiversity Winery Initiative for conservation practices and initiatives, Certified ISO 14001 for environmental sustainability practices and Accredited and Founding Member of The Wine Industry Ethical Trade Association, dedicated to the promotion and practice of "fair trade" in the agricultural industry.

GB makes elegant still wines at a fraction of the price of domestic producers.

Two dual varietal wines (Chard/Viognier and Shiraz/Cab) have been produced to compete at the sub \$10 retail market. These are great house wines or options for retailers who are looking for more elegant "Wednesday wine" to stock. The 2007 Shiraz/Cab was selected by Wine Enthusiast as one of the top 100 value wines in 2009.

Social responsibility.

Graham Beck Wines operates like a non-profit here in the States, as they reinvest all of the profits back into the winery, providing jobs and job training programs for the people of South Africa. Additionally, the Becks have built schools, universities and daycare facilities throughout South Africa for low income communities.
