

Vintner Barry Waitte founded Tamber Bey Vineyards in 1999, when he purchased a 60-acre vineyard in the Yountville Appellation, and an 11-acre property in the renowned Oakville Appellation. In 2012, Waitte purchased the 22-acre Sundance Ranch in Calistoga, and converted the covered riding arena into a 60,000 gallon wine making facility. Today, Tamber Bey's portfolio of wines are made under the leadership of winemaker Andy Jones with founding winemaker Brown as consulting winemaker. The wines are made from Waitte's estate-grown fruit from the Yountville and Oakville AVA's, and from grapes carefully sourced from select vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and Lake counties.

**2017 Sauvignon Blanc, Lizzy's Vineyard, Oakville**

Flavors of green apple and starfruit give way to a refreshing, yet long lasting mouthfeel and texture which is framed by a vibrant acidity.

**2017 Rosé, Fore Vineyard, Red Hills, Lake County**

The mouthfeel has layers of rose petal, cotton candy and watermelon flesh. The crisp acidity completes this wine, and leave your palate thirsty for more.

**2016 Cabernet Sauvignon, Deux Chevaux Vineyard**

Flavors of crème de cassis, toasted vanilla, and boysenberry are layered with chalky tannins that provide a lengthy finish. for more.

**2016 Merlot, Deux Chevaux Vineyard, Yountville**

This aromatic, fruit-forward wine delivers a core of black fruit, with black currant and notes of chocolate. It is full-bodied, with a well-integrated texture and velvety tannins. for more.

**2017 Chardonnay, Sans Chene, Yountville**

Fresh flavors of golden delicious apple, guava, mango and pear introduce a bright acidity which makes this wine very enjoyable on a hot day. **92 points, Wine Spectator.**

**2017 Pinot Noir**

A medium-weight and subtle tannin structure with flavors of tart red cherry, strawberry seed and roses that are a pleasant introduction to the lingering finish.

**2016 Chardonnay, Unoaked, Yountville**

There is a mineral layer and a little bit of yeastiness that adds complexity. The finish is long, with apple and white peach notes. **90 points, Wine Spectator.**

**2016 Rabicano, Deux Chevaux Vineyard, Yountville**

An impressive blend of 69 per cent cabernet sauvignon and 22 per cent merlot with touches of malbec, petit verdot and cabernet franc. **93 points, James Suckling.**

**2015 Cabernet Sauvignon, Estate Vineyard, Oakville**

This wine expresses flavors consisting of baked rhubarb and cranberry, with layers of cocoa, blackberry and vanilla extract. The minerality consists of crushed rock, and is balanced by a smooth chalky tannin.

## 2017 Chardonnay

*Sans Chêne*, Yountville AVA

This wine is primarily from the same Dijon Chardonnay Clone that is in the renowned Deux Chevaux Vineyard Chardonnay, and supplemented with the Wenté clone. Fermented and aged entirely in Stainless Steel, this new wine brings out and incredible bright and fresh sensation of the fruit. *Sans Chêne* is 'With-out Oak' in French.

### *Winemaker Notes*


By blocking malolactic fermentation and fermenting this wine in stainless steel, we are able to preserve a beautiful freshness to the wine. Striking scents of tropical banana, and pineapple blend with floral notes of jasmine and hydrangea. Fresh flavors of golden delicious apple, guava, mango and pear introduce a bright acidity which makes this wine very enjoyable on a hot day.

### *Vineyards:*

The fruit for this wine comes from two Yountville vineyards, the estate owned Deux Chevaux Vineyard located on the northern Yountville AVA, and the Trio Vineyard located on the south western side of the Yountville AVA.

### *About Tamber Bey*

With a winery located in Calistoga at the Sundance Ranch, Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation, as well as sourced fruit from seven premium vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and Lake counties. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte's first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey).

## 2017 Sauvignon Blanc

*Lizzy's Vineyard, Oakville AVA*

This Tamber Bey Sauvignon Blanc is from a sourced vineyard in the Northern bench of the Yountville Appellation in Napa valley, noted for its rocky and mineral rich soils. Winemaker Andy Jones uses a unique aging and barrel program for this wine, aging 50% of the wine for six months in Acacia wood barrels and the other 50% in stainless steel. The use of Acacia wood barrels respects the elegance of the Sauvignon Blanc fruit, and it brings a unique character feeling and texture to the palate.

### *Winemaker Notes:*


When first poured into the glass, bright aromas of ginger, grapefruit, lemongrass and fresh kiwi transition into floral notes of lavender and white peach. Flavors of green apple and starfruit give way to a refreshing, yet long lasting mouthfeel and texture which is framed by a vibrant acidity.

### *Lizzy's Vineyard*

Lizzy's Vineyard sits off the Southern Oakville bench located outside the historic town of Oakville in the Napa Valley. Towards the western side of the vineyard, the soil is grayish loam clay on which both Musque and Sauvignon Blanc have thrived. These 8 year old vines produce a Sauvignon Blanc highlighted with a citrus zest and a fine grained volcanic minerality.

## 2017 Rosé

### Red Hills AVA, Lake County

This Tamber Bey Rosé is Rhone blend of Syrah, Grenache and Mourvedre, made in the true spirit of a Provence style Rosé from fruit grown in the Red Hills AVA of Lake County.

#### *Winemaker Notes*


The blend of Syrah, Mourvèdre, and Grenache make this wine one of both complexity and approachability. Notes of strawberry rhubarb, white peach, and hibiscus evolve into scents of cream soda, and bright Bing cherries. The mouthfeel has layers of rose petal, cotton candy and watermelon flesh. The crisp acidity completes this wine, and leave your palate thirsty for more.

#### *Fore Vineyard, Red Hills AVA*

Located in the northern Mayacamas Mountains, the Red Hills of Lake County frame the southwest edge of Clear Lake. Comprised of dozens of volcanic hills ranging from 1,350 to over 3,700 feet above sea level, the appellation lies right over the North Coast Magna Pocket. As a result, the Red Hills are the latest formation of the volcanic and tectonic processes that created many of the famous hillside regions of the North Coast.

## 2017 Pinot Noir

Sun Chase Vineyard, Petaluma Gap AVA

### *Winemaker Notes*


The 2017 Sun Chase Vineyard Pinot Noir is comprised of three clones fermented separately, each selected to make this distinct, site-specific wine. The wine presents a medium-weight and subtle tannin structure. Flavors of tart red cherry, strawberry seed and roses are a pleasant introduction to the lingering finish.

### *Sun Chase Vineyard*

This 40-acre vineyard is located in the Petaluma Gap region of the Sonoma Coast at an elevation of 900 to 1,200 feet, on the western slope of Sonoma Mountain. Sun Chase Vineyard is above the fog line and therefore the fruit sees sun all day – every day. Tamber Bey source about 8 tons of meticulously farmed Pinot Noir fruit of three French clones, Dijon 828, 667 and 777.


### *Winemaker Notes*

This luscious Chardonnay is aged in 100% stainless steel, hence the term 'unoaked'. The primary aromas are dominated by banana and pear, and then evolve into apple and white flower notes. In addition to its classic fruitiness, there is a mineral layer and a little bit of yeastiness that adds complexity. The finish is long, with apple and white peach notes.

## 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon

Deux Chevaux Vineyard, Yountville AVA

Our Cabernet Sauvignon from the Deux Chevaux Vineyard is Tamber Bey's original wine, with a 50-case first release back in in 2001. This wine is a classic Napa valley-floor Cabernet Sauvignon, with richness and well-balanced, approachable elegance.

### *James Suckling – 92 Points*


A super plush and richly fruited cab that has a wealth of rich and ripe red-plum flavor and a sleek, smoothly arranged palate that delivers freshness and depth with effortless style. Pure cabernet sauvignon. Drink or hold. JS

### *Winemaker Notes*

First impressions of dark plum, blackberry and confectionary notes of cocoa with coffee grounds evolve from the glass. These aromatics, paired with notes of allspice and vanilla, provide a subtle preview into the mouthfeel of the wine. Flavors of crème de cassis, toasted vanilla, and boysenberry are layered with chalky tannins that provide a lengthy finish. The growing season of 2016 allowed us to harvest these grapes at optimal ripeness, which resulted in a beautiful wine that can be enjoyed early on with a proper decant.

### *Deux Chevaux Vineyard*

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, northeast of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for “two horses,” which is the namesake of Tamber Bey.



## 2016 Rabicano

### Deux Chevaux Vineyard, Yountville AVA

Tamber Bey's estate-grown Bordeaux-blend wine, Rabicano (pronounced Rab-i-kawno), is a masterful blend that exhibits the unique traits of the Deux Chevaux Vineyard, a strong core of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot with the bolstering power of Petit Verdot and the aromatics of Cabernet Franc. Planted in 2002, This was Tamber Bey's original blend that inspired three other blends: Sabino, Tovero and Vermejo.

### *James Suckling – 93 Points*


An impressive blend of 69 per cent cabernet sauvignon and 22 per cent merlot with touches of malbec, petit verdot and cabernet franc, that delivers focused dark-fruit aromas, ahead of a core of ripe blackcurrants that surround a smooth, central core of plush, fine tannins. Balanced and flavorful. Drink or hold. JS

### *Andy Jones - Winemaker Notes*

The power of this wine comes from the Cabernet Sauvignon, which is softened by the addition of Merlot, most notably in the aromatics. The combination of Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec all connect to layer the varietals and make this wine very approachable early on in its life.

### *Deux Chevaux Vineyard*

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, northeast of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for “two horses,” the namesake of Tamber Bey.

## 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon

Oakville Estate Vineyard, Oakville AVA

Our original Signature wine started in 2002, this Cabernet is all about the Oakville AVA. The fruit is from the Estate grown Oakville vineyard with dense cane pruned vines to bring the full impact of the Oakville soil into the body of this wine.

### *Winemaker Notes*


Aromas of black cherry, cola and cassis are intertwined with scents of leather, olive and walnut skin. With time, notes of plum and baked pie crust are also evident. Being a fruit forward Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine expresses flavors consisting of baked rhubarb and cranberry, with layers of cocoa, blackberry and vanilla extract. The minerality consists of crushed rock, and is balanced by a smooth chalky tannin.

### *Oakville Estate Vineyard*

The Tamber Bey Oakville Estate is located at the southern end of Napa Valley's famous Oakville appellation, just north of Yountville. It has gravel/loam soils that are relatively shallow and well suited to Cabernet. The site enjoys early morning fog and late afternoon breezes influenced by the San Francisco Bay to the south. To encourage competition for sun, water and nutrients, Tamber Bey planted more than 9,500 vines in a tight planting formation on 3 acres.
