## Jules Taylor OTQ Rosé 2018

One of the finest rosés I've tried from New Zealand, the 2018 OTQ Pinot Noir Rose features intense, attractive aromas of strawberries and pineapple. Medium-bodied, it tastes virtually dry, with enough silky-creamy texture on the mid-palate and length on the finish to keep me coming back for sip after sip.



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From the Meadowbank Vineyard, the 2017 OTQ Single Vineyard Chardonnay features high-quality toasty oak up front, backed by notes of grilled pears and pineapple. It's medium-bodied, with just enough plump generosity to round out the mid-palate, and it has a crisp, lingering finish. It should drink well for another 5 years.
